## **SUSAN KADIS MP APPOINTED CRITIC FOR NATIONAL REVENUE**

Ottawa – Susan Kadis, Member of Parliament for Thornhill was appointed today to the Shadow Cabinet as Critic for National Revenue by the leader of the Official Opposition the Hon. Stéphane Dion.
