MP Kadis critical of Prime Minister Skipping out on Kyoto Vote

Ottawa- Thornhill MP Susan Kadis is dismayed that Prime Minister Harper skipped out on the Liberal opposition day motion reconfirming Canada's commitment to the Kyoto Protocol introduced by the Leader of the Opposition, the Honourable Stéphane Dion. The motion easily passed in the House of Commons with support from all opposition parties with no support from the Conservative government.

"Although Prime Minister Harper was in Ottawa yesterday, he was not present in the House for the vote. By skipping out on this vote, on such a significant issue, Mr. Harper has again failed Thornhill residents and all Canadians on the environment," stated Mrs. Kadis.

On February 1st, Thornhill MP Susan Kadis represented her constituents proudly in the House of Commons speaking favour of Mr. Dion's motion.
