Thornhill M.P. Susan Kadis calls on government to honour commitment to GTA in upcoming budget

OTTAWA – Thornhill M.P. Susan Kadis, the associate critic for Infrastructure and Communities, is urging the government to commit to renewing existing infrastructure programs and public transit like VIVA Rapid Transit in tomorrow’s budget. Mrs. Kadis is also calling on the government to commit funds to the expansion of the TTC Spadina subway line into Vaughan.

“As I have stated in the House, the province has put its money on the table for the expansion of the Spadina subway line into Vaughan. Where is the federal government?” said Mrs. Kadis. “These investments are imperative and I fully support the next phase of the VIVA Rapid Transit funding and expanding the Spadina subway line into Vaughan.”

Mrs. Kadis said that given that this government inherited the healthiest fiscal situation of any incoming government since Confederation, it therefore has the financial capacity to do right by our municipalities and invest in infrastructure.

“Due to 13 years of sound Liberal fiscal policies, this government has enough money to make these investments,” said Mrs. Kadis. “In an era of such unprecedented national wealth, this is not the time to be making large scale cuts.”
