Thornhill M.P. Susan Kadis deeply concerned with the new U.N. Human Rights Council

THORNHILL – Thornhill M.P. Susan Kadis is deeply concerned that the new U.N. Human Rights Council will continue where the old commission left off – with unabashed bias and unfair chastising of the State of Israel.

“Regardless of some changes, the bottom line is nations with clear and well-documented human rights abuses and strong opposition to the existence of the State of Israel were elected to the new council,” Mrs. Kadis said. “Canada took a leadership role in trying to replace the old Human Rights Commission, which was blatantly biased against Israel and lacked any credibility.”

“With all the effort we have made trying to revamp this body, the changes do not likely go far enough to make this new council a credible, accountable and effective world body,” Mrs. Kadis said. “I along with others will certainly be watching closely to ensure the new council is not a replica of the previous discredited commission.”
