Thornhill MP Susan Kadis expresses condolences to the family of York Region Police Officer killed in the line of duty

THORNHILL, ON – Thornhill MP Susan Kadis expresses condolences to the family, friends and fellow officers of Constable Robert Plunkett of the York Regional Police, who died in the line of duty earlier today.

“Constable Plunkett paid the ultimate price while helping to protect the people of our community,” said Mrs. Kadis. “My deepest sympathies are with his family, friends and fellow officers.”

According to a York Regional Police announcement, Constable Plunkett was killed in the line of duty this morning while attempting to make an arrest. Two parties have been arrested in connection with the incident.

Constable Robert Plunkett was 43 years old, and a 22-year veteran with the force. He was a member of the Special Services Unit.

“We are all proud of the dedication that our men and women in uniform display every day they are on duty,” said Mrs. Kadis. “and are saddened by this tragic loss.”
